STEP 1: ADMISSION TO MCC (must be fully admitted)

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- ▶ Application for Admission to MCC (indicate **DHT** program on application)
- ▶ Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- ▶ All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ▶ ACT Scores, if taken (**MCC does not accept residual ACT scores**)

- _____ Completion of all prerequisites with a 'C' average or higher in each class.
- _____ Cumulative GPA of **2.00** on college coursework
- _____ Submit observation hours and applicant information form by **MAY 1st**
