



**Medical Assisting Technology (MET)** is a 2-year degree program that is a multi-skilled health education profession whose practitioners work primarily in ambulatory settings, such as medical offices and clinics. Medical Assistants function as members of the health care delivery team and perform both business administrative and clinical procedures.

**STEP 1: ADMISSION TO MCC (must be fully admitted)**

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- ▶ Application for Admission to MCC (indicate **MET** program on general application)
- ▶ Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- ▶ All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ▶ ACT Scores, if taken (**MCC does not accept residual ACT scores**)
- ▶ ACCUPLACER scores (if applicable), **must be administered at Meridian Community College**

**NOTE:** Applications may be accepted after the deadline based on program availability.

**THERE IS NOT A SEPARATE APPLICATION TO COMPLETE TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS PROGRAM.**

\_\_\_\_\_ Completion of at least **15 semester hours** of general education coursework with a 'C' average or above in each class. Developmental coursework does not satisfy this requirement.

\_\_\_\_\_ Cumulative GPA of **2.00** on college course work.
