



**Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT)** is a 2-year degree program that prepares individuals to work in a clinical laboratory. Students will perform a wide range of routine laboratory procedures associated with blood and body-fluid analysis.

**STEP 1: ADMISSION TO MCC (must be fully admitted)**

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- ▶ Application for Admission to MCC (indicate **MLT** program on application)
- ▶ Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- ▶ All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ▶ ACT Scores, if taken (**MCC does not accept residual ACT scores**)
- ▶ ACCUPLACER scores (if applicable), **must be administered at Meridian Community College**

**NOTE:** Applications may be accepted after the deadline based on program availability.

**THERE IS NOT A SEPARATE APPLICATION TO COMPLETE TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS PROGRAM.**
