



**Radiologic Technology Program (RGT)** is a 2-year degree program designed to prepare students for entry-level positions in the field of radiology. Through six consecutive semesters of academic, laboratory and clinical training, students acquire knowledge and hands on experience to be an integral part of a dynamic healthcare team. General education and radiography courses are taught on campus with clinical experiences provided in local and out-of-town radiology centers. This program will not prepare students that are interested in a career pertaining to ultrasound.

**STEP 1: ADMISSION TO MCC (must be fully admitted)**

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- ▶ Application for Admission to MCC (indicate **RGT** program on general application)
- ▶ Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- ▶ All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ▶ ACT Scores, if taken (**MCC does not accept residual ACT scores**)
