

# Point System for the Associate Degree Nursing Programs

Implemented: February 21, 2003 (Revised: 2013)

**Applicants receive residency points for one of the following:**

Residency Status	Points Awarded
Out of State	1
Mississippi Resident (In-state)	2
Lauderdale Co. Resident (In-district)	4
Current MCC Student	4

**Applicants receive points based on their national ACT composite score. The residual ACT is not accepted by MCC.**

ACT Composite Score	Points Awarded
17	1
18-20	2
21-24	3
25-28	4
29 or above	5

**Applicants receive points for cumulative GPA, which is based on all college coursework.**

Cumulative GPA	Points Awarded
2.0-2.5	1
2.6-3.0	2
3.1-3.5	3
3.6 or above	4

**Applicants receive points for coursework based on the grade earned in each individual course.**

**Points for science courses are based on the lecture grade if lab is taken as a separate course.**
